Introduction

"Let's work and play! Do you want to play with mom and dad? Let's go! Today we are going to play with oranges. What is this? It is an orange!" Let him/her play and touch the oranges.

LANGUAGE

VOCABULARY: COLOUR (ORANGE) AND
FRUIT (ORANGE).



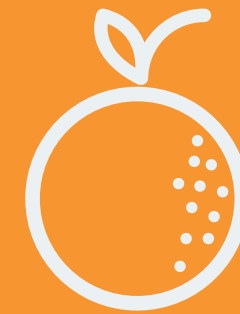
Always use the same sentences in a playful way, we want our kids to be motivated to play with us. First you will say the question and also the answer, in order to show him/her what him/her is the correct answer and what they have to repeat later. "What is this? This is an orange". After a few times you will say: "What is this?" and look at him/her smiling with a question face. Maybe the first times he/she is not going to answer you,... but he/she will do it eventually, when he/she gets it, please, please REINFORCE him/her, saying "Good job!", high five!,...hug him, clap,... You can also say what is the colour of the orange? Orange too!!.



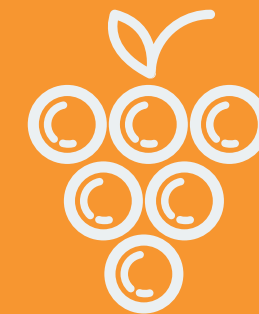
PRE-POST ACTIVITIES



Please remember to say all the things we are trying to learn: “Look, what is this? Orange circles! let’s jump Inside! Repeating and repeating in different ways is the key of the young children’s learning. That is why we prepare different activities to teach the same content (language, math and big motor skills).



Read a book about fruits (example here), (language and social skills).



Watch a video about fruits (youtube, youku), (language and technology).



MATH 1

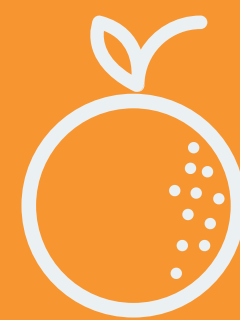
SHAPE: CIRCLE, AND FINE MOTOR SKILLS.





Introduce to your child what is a circle, using a book, drawing a face,...Prepare a big white cardboard or a piece of paper and some orange paint (finger paint, water colour paint), paper towels, paper plates. Put the paint on the plate. Use the orange half to stamp on the paper: what shape can you see?... It's a circle!!! Let your child experience and play, be prepared and don't stress with the mess X). Repeat many times "Wow, what a nice circle!" "What is that? It's a circle!!!". Don't forget to reinforce his/her achievements and have fun with your child.

PRE-POST ACTIVITIES



Print a picture of an orange and paint with crayons (fine motor skills and language).



Play with orange playdough and make balls like oranges (fine motor skills and language).



“Circle hunting”, pretend you are explorers and hunt things at your house with circle shape (Big motor skills and language).

MATH 2

NUMBERS: 1,2 AND 3.



A. Prepare 3 pieces of paper or a cardboard with the number 1, 2 and 3 written on them. Playing with the oranges, you can say: "How many oranges do we have?" Count to 3 (1, 2 and...3! Very Good!). You can play with your child and ask him/her to give you, 1 orange or 2 or 3. Don't stress if he/she doesn't give you the correct answer,...we are learning! every time you say a number (Can you give me 2 oranges, please?), point at the number on the paper. We are trying to match the quantity with the written number.

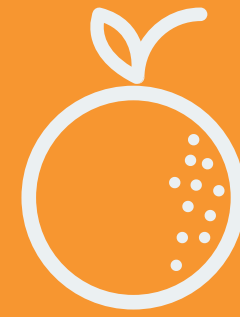
B. Prepare 3 boxes: Put oranges inside (box 1: 1 orange; box 2: 2 oranges and box 3: 3 oranges), stick the number on the box. Play with the oranges: "This is the number one, lets leave 1 orange inside",....



PRE-POST ACTIVITIES



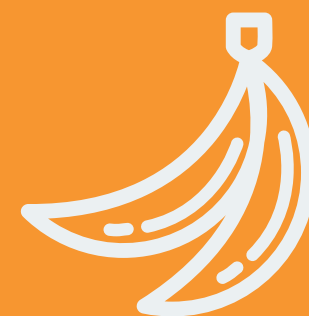
Remember to say "1.2 and 3" when you are working on your routines: in the stairs, washing your hands, preparing the table to eat, taking the things you need to cook, playing with your toys,... (language and math).



Look at a picture about a boy inside a box and describe the situation. Now it is your turn, play to jump inside and outside a box saying "inside and outside" and the same time (language, math and big motor skills).



Make orange circles cutting some cardboard or paper (big enough to jump inside) and stick them on the hallway, then you can play jumping inside them.



Read a book about numbers (language, math, social skills). Watch a video about numbers (language, math, technology).



INSIDE/OUTSIDE

Putting the oranges inside and outside the bucket.

MOTOR SKILLS

Jumping inside the circles.



INQUIRY

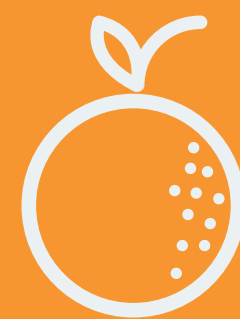
HOW THE WORLD WORKS: PROFESSIONS.

Prepare an orange. Cut the orange, show him/her how is the orange inside, touch it, smell it... Let your child play and taste the orange (clean his/her hands first!). Take another orange. Make orange juice together. You can say to him/her: "Orange juice makes you stronger!".



PRE-POST ACTIVITIES



Watch a video about what is a nurse and a doctor (language and inquiry).

Paint a doctor and a nurse (fine motor skills and inquiry).



Watch a video about why orange juice makes you stronger (language and inquiry)

Paint a "Super orange" (fine motor skills, language and inquiry).



Pretend to be a doctor and a patient. It will be very fun for him/her if you have toys or costumes. You can also do it by yourself (social skills and inquiry).

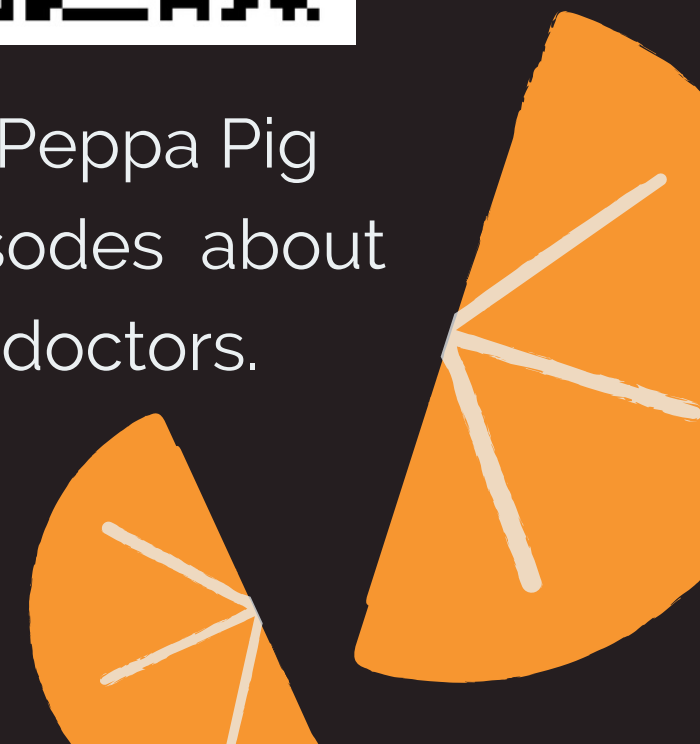
