

PRESCHOOL CAMPING FINE MOTOR

To prepare

- A4 paper
- Printer
- Coloring crayons or dry erase markers if you choose to laminate the activity
- Scissors (to cut and separate the cards)
- Laminator

Method of use:

Need your preschool kids to practice their fine motor and pre-writing skills? Laminate these mats and store them in your fine motor centers for a quick and easy pull out and use activity. After you've laminated the mats, you can choose to cut each mat into strips or simply use them each as a mat. I think it's a good idea to laminate and cut up the strips so that you can differentiate the activity with kids just starting to work on their pre-writing skills. Have the kids use a dry erase marker to trace each line to help the camper get to the tent. The kids should not veer too far away from the line, just have them repeat the activity at a later stage until they perfect this skill.



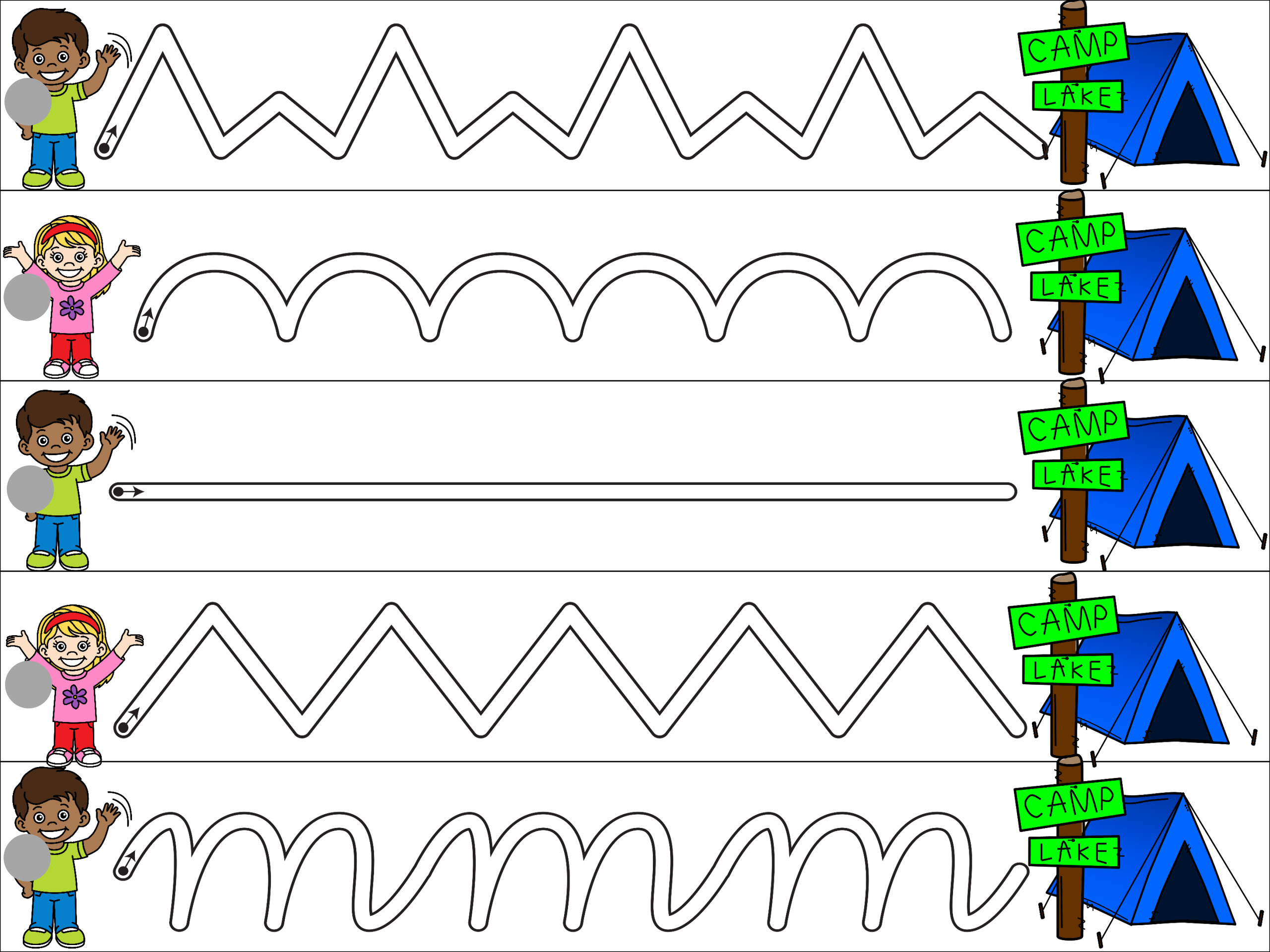
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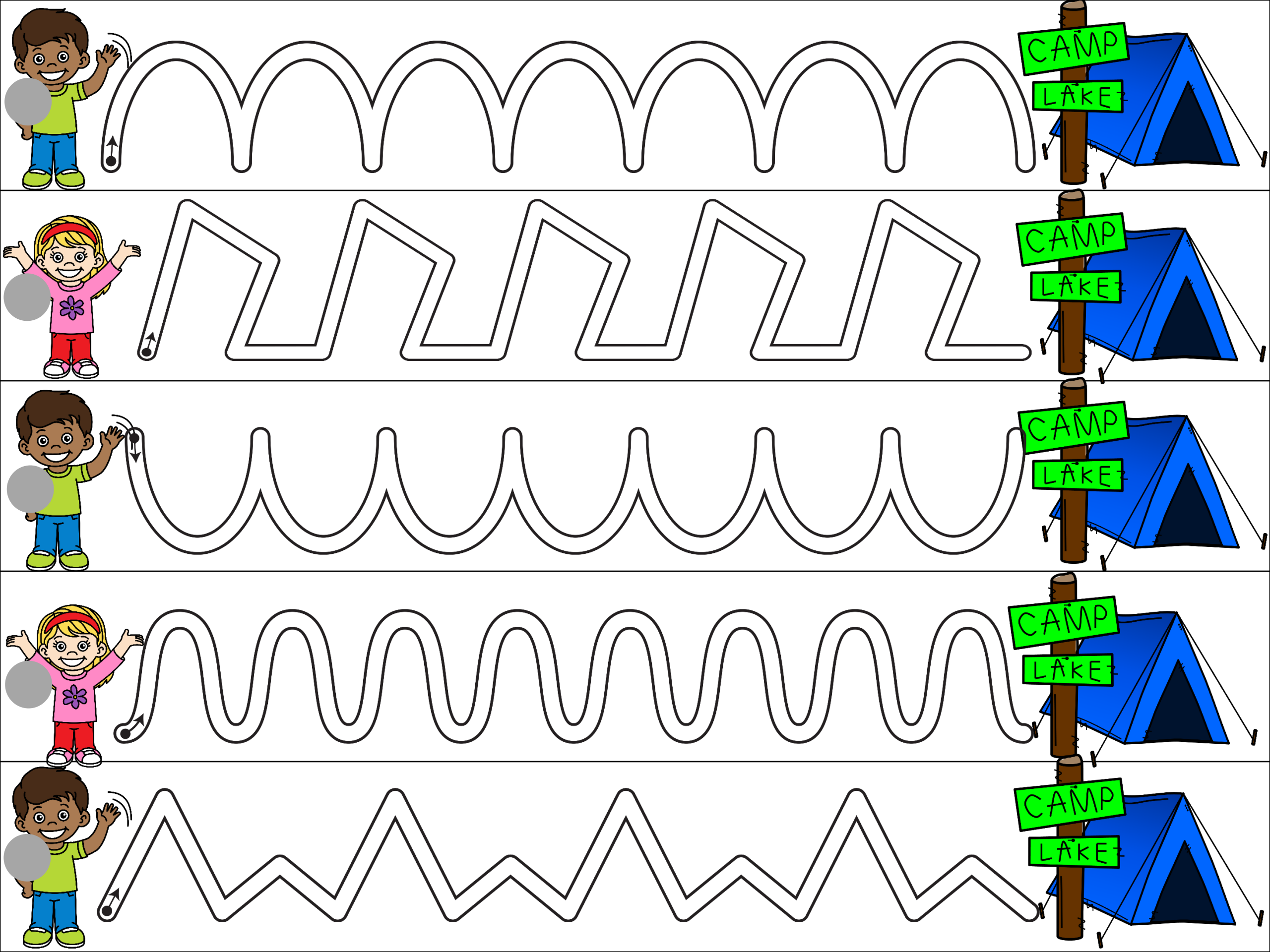
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
